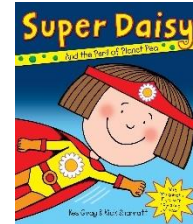
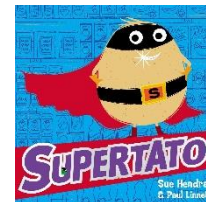
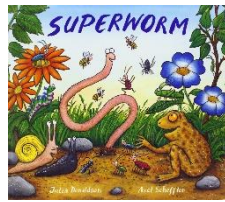
Nursery – Spring Term 2

Our Learning

Our learning this half term will be linked to our topic, and children will have lots of opportunities in different areas of learning, such as:

Literacy – Looking at story picture cards and use stick puppets to develop our storytelling, make marks and put meanings to them, develop our pencil grip and control.

Maths – Recognising different numbers, creating different amounts and matching numeral to quantity, developing our counting skills and use numicon.

Understanding the World – Exploring flowers, looking at potatoes and how they grow, looking at worms and their homes, and exploring around the world.

Art and Design – using their imagination to create their own art and develop different art skills such as printing.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development – Exploring a healthy diet and continuing to develop our social skills and understanding of emotions.

Home Learning

Here are some different activities to try at home based around our topic. Any pictures or work can be sent into school, so children are able to share it with their friends and teachers for us to celebrate.

- Make a superhero mask out of some old cardboard or cereal box. Decorate it and write your superhero name on.
- Use an old potato and make your own supertato!
- Talk about people who we think are superheroes, such as people who help us like doctors.
- Can you do some superhero exercises? Try 10 star jumps, 10 super high jumps and a 10 second balance.



Talk for Writing

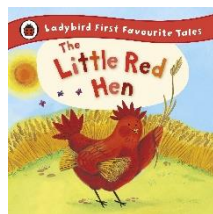


Talk for Writing

We have been spending time developing our storytelling skills through our talk for writing lessons.

Last half term, children learnt the nursery rhyme 'The Wheels on the Bus'. The children spent time learning actions to help them retell it. See if they can show you!

This half term, we will be looking at the story 'The Little Red Hen'. Children will also be spending time drawing their own story maps and innovating the story – which is where they change different parts to make it their own.
