Year 1:

Year 3:

Studying the genre of botanical art to create natural weavings, two-colour prints and detailed botanical paintings of fruit.



Mosaic Masters

Studying the history of mosaics, before focusing on the colours, patterns and themes found in Roman mosaic.



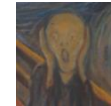
Year 5:

Islamic Art

Exploring geometric shapes used in Islamic art to create relief sculptures based on geometric motifs.

Exploring the concepts and visual characteristics of abstraction and distortion.

Exploring scientific drawings and combining materials to create detailed illustrations.
