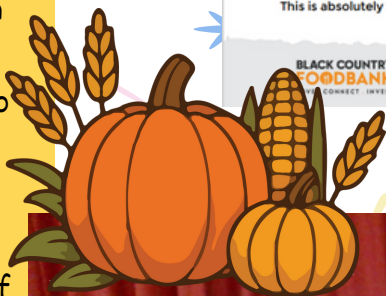
To all at Sledmere Primary School,
