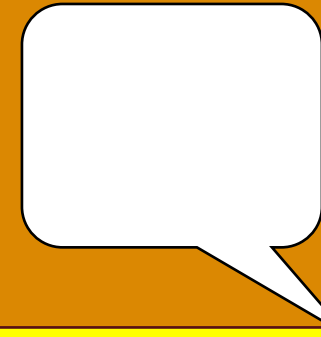
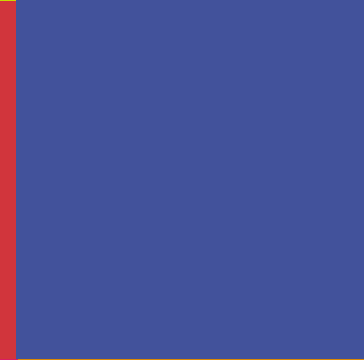
MUSIC
